

Who Can Stay at the Lexington Ronald McDonald House?

The Lexington Ronald McDonald House serves families of children 21 years and under that are being treated by local medical facilities. Our rooms can accommodate up to four family members. Families staying at the Lexington Ronald McDonald House for the first time must be referred by a social worker. Only one room is available per family.

Room availability

The House does not take advance reservations. If you're interested in staying with us, talk to your social worker about securing a room. They will call us with a referral the day the room is needed. To ensure the comfort and safety of all our guests, each individual over the age of 18 on the referral must have a background check prior to arrival and bring with them a government issued photo ID.

What if a room is not available?

Families stay as long as their child is receiving medical services. We never know how long a family will be staying, so we cannot take advance reservations. If a room is available at the time you call and you meet the requirements, it will be assigned to you. If we are full, your name will be placed on a wait list in the order in which you called. You will stay on the wait list until a room becomes available.

How much does it cost to stay at the Ronald McDonald House?

The Lexington Ronald McDonald House suggests a donation of \$10 per night. Any family unable to make the donation can still stay at the Ronald McDonald House for as long as their child is receiving medical services.

What are the Hours of the Ronald McDonald House?

The House is accessible to families 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. Visitors are welcome between the hours of 8 am to 11 pm.

How big is the Ronald McDonald House?

The Lexington House is a two story building and has 21 private rooms. The House has many amenities to make our guests comfortable as possible.

- **Kitchen Facilities:** All families are provided with a small refrigerator and a cabinet space to store dry goods. A large kitchen and dining area allow ample room for all of our guests to make themselves at home.

- **Meals:** Dinner is provided by volunteers at 7:00 pm. We also offer breakfast at 10:00 am most weekends. Snacks and fresh coffee are also available to guests.

- **Laundry Facilities:** Washers and dryers, as well as detergent and bleach are provided.

- **Play Spaces:** We have a fun play room available for guests. We have a library of books, games, and videos and a pool table available for use by our families.

- **Shuttle van service:** The Ronald McDonald House offers shuttle van service to and from the hospitals for guests staying at the House.

What will I find in the guest room?

Each newly renovated guest room is furnished with two double beds or a queen bed donated by Tempur-Sealy International, a sleeper chair, a private bath, telephone, and toiletries. Rollaway beds and cribs are available upon request. However, supplies are limited.
